Free rapid coronavirus testing is available in the borough of Broxbourne

for anyone who does not have coronavirus symptoms

Rapid testing can show if you have coronavirus even though you do NOT have symptoms.

Around one in three people who are infected with COVID-19 have no symptoms and are likely to be spreading the virus to their loved ones without realising.

Getting a rapid test means that you can protect your family, friends and community by helping to stop the spread of the virus.
