Introduction

If a medical professional advises that clinical waste produced at home due to a medical condition will be infectious or hazardous, then:

- you cannot dispose of it as normal domestic waste
- you must make special collection arrangements by completing this application form.

Special collection services for infectious or hazardous waste

Service type

Service details

Orange sacks

Use these for infectious waste such as dressings used to treat wounds and for stoma bags.

- are provided and collected weekly free of charge
- will be replaced at the time of collection
- should be put out on the doorstep before 7am on collection day
- must NEVER be used for needles or other sharps or for general waste.



Sharps box – yellow lid

Use this for syringe needles, cartridges and any other contaminated disposable instruments.

Sharps boxes

- are collected and replaced free of charge
- should be sealed and put out on the doorstep before 7am on collection day
- Collections must be booked 48 hours in advance (contact details overleaf).



Sharps box – purple lid

Use this for cytotoxic and cytostatic products only.
